Holland's Kev Black and the Muffdivers first release is a six song rockabilly and surf CD with three intros and three vocals. The music is thick and intense at times, and well developed, with sophisticated changes and intrigue.

"Arabian Shake" ★★★★★

Middle eastern runs, dry, almost oud-like guitar tone, and Bedouin drama, and Cossack shouts. On the grodie side, "Arabian Shake" is nonetheless a fine track with a tuft mysterious edge. There's a narrated verse, but that doesn't keep it from being a very cool adventure. Thick and crunchy in the middle, and very groovy.
